Dear Church Family,

'But a Samaritan, as he travelled, came where the man was; and when he saw him, he took pity on him. He went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine. Then he put the man on his own donkey, brought him to an inn and took care of him.'

Luke 10:33 & 34

In the parable of 'The Good Samaritan', which Jesus told to demonstrate who our neighbour is, we find compassion and help coming from an unlikely source.

The victim of a violent robbery is helped, not by respectable members of his own people group, but by someone for whom he would have had no time in other circumstances.

I love the detail Jesus includes. Pity leads to aid; aid to rescue and rescue to aftercare.

We may not be able to be present or give much practical aid to people who are currently in need but we can surround them with our prayers and trust that the presence of God will make the difference in their lives.
